

Wallingford's Chinoise Café Closes

Seattle, Wash. – After seven years of serving the Seattle community, Chinoise Café restaurant on 45th Street in Wallingford has closed its doors. Chinoise Cafe's other two locations at 12 Boston Street in Upper Queen Anne and 2801 East Madison Street in Madison Valley are still open and operating. Sunday, May 18, 2008, was the final day of business for Chinoise Café on 45th.

“The decision to close Chinoise Café was a long and difficult one that required a great deal of thought and discussion,” said Thoa Nguyen, Chinoise Café's owner and chef de cuisine. “Feng He and I talked about this for a long time, and in the end, we decided to sell the restaurant and move on.”

Feng He, the head sushi chef at Chinoise on 45th, will remain in Seattle and will continue serving sushi at Chinoise's Queen Anne location. Thoa Nguyen will also continue her role as owner and chef de cuisine at Chinoise other locations.

To all of the loyal customers and sushi lovers who regularly visited Chinoise on 45th, Thoa Nguyen and Feng He are extremely grateful and welcome those patrons to visit them again at one of their other locations.
